1976 Mycological Weekend

A three-day Mycological Weekend will be held at the Pocono Environmental Education Center (PEEC) in Dingman's Ferry, Pennsylvania. It will be held in conjunction with the Connecticut Valley Mycological Society. The three-day event will begin on Friday, June 18th, at 8:00 p.m. with a supper. Following supper, there will be an orientation session and then a wine and cheese tasting party where everyone can get acquainted. The weekend is scheduled through 1:00 p.m. Sunday, June 20th. There will be workshops, slides with lectures, mushroom tasting and cooking demonstrations, displays with identification plus swimming and sauna baths for anyone interested.

Accommodations have been reserved for seventy persons, so, if you are interested, please send in your registration fee as soon as

possible. If you procrastinate, you may miss out on what promises to be a fantastic weekend.

The rates are as follows:

Registration Fee..... \$5.00 per person (children under 5 years of age free.)

Registration Fee is not refundable.

Food & Lodging..... \$23.00 per person (1/2 price for children 5 years old & under.)

This includes a total of six meals; one meal on Friday, three on Saturday, and two on Sunday.

Seven cottages have been reserved. Each cottage can accommodate ten persons, and in some cottages there are several rooms. All the cottages have a large ceramic-tiled bathroom with shower and tub. Most have cut stone fireplaces with raised fieldstone hearths. Bunk beds, mattresses, pillows, chairs, lamps, dressers, curtains, and housekeeping equipment are provided.

At the facility is a dining hall which can accommodate 150 persons, a main building with four large rooms for meetings, and many other auxiliary buildings.

I think you will agree that the costs are very reasonable. You may invite a non-member if you wish. If you intend to go, please fill out the registration form completely.

Registration fees will not be accepted after seventy persons have registered or after May 31, 1976, whichever occurs first.
