The August 9 foray will be to Stephen's State park. Stephens is located on Route 604, 7 miles south of Route 206 and 1½ miles from Route 46 in Hackettstown. Jim Richards will lead.

From the East: Route I-80 West to Exit 25 (Route 206 North - Newton), turn left at second traffic light (¾ mile) onto Route 604 South. The Park entrance is located 7 miles on the left. (Watch for House of Good Shepherd sign)

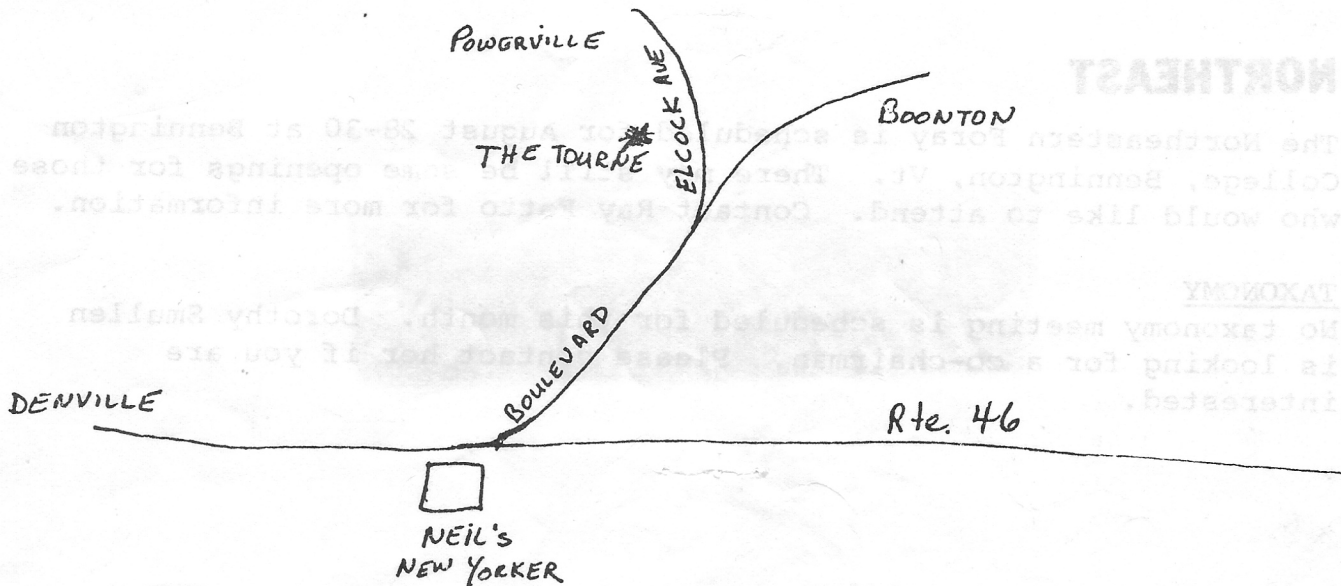
From the South: At the intersection of Routes 46 and 183 in Hackettstown, turn right onto Rte. 604 (Willow Grove St.) at David's Country Inn. Stephens State Park is 1½ miles on the right.

1/5th of a mile after entering the Park, make a right turn over the bridge at the stop sign. We will meet at the lower picnic area which is the second right turn.

THE TOURNE

The August 16 foray will be to the Tourne Park near Boonton.

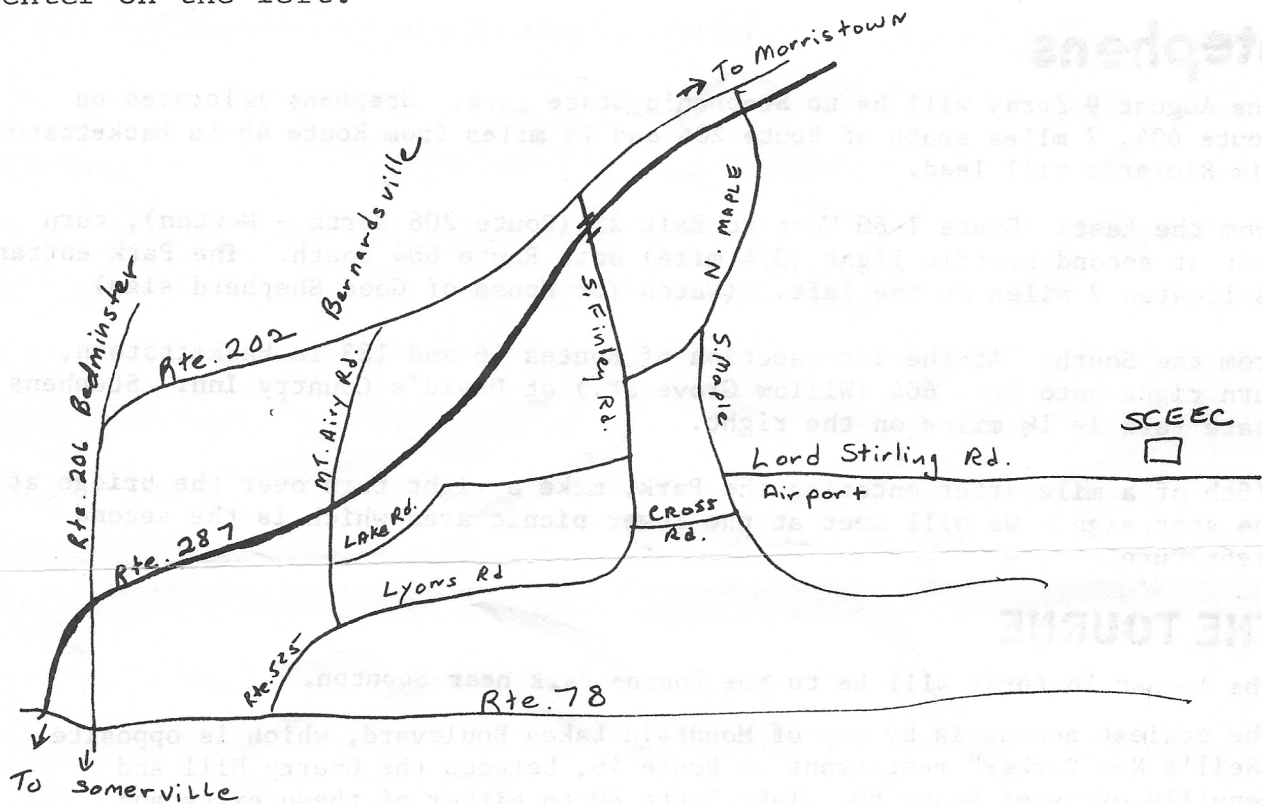
The easiest access is by way of Mountain Lakes Boulevard, which is opposite "Neil's New Yorker" restaurant on Route 46, between the Cherry Hill and Denville exits of Route 80. Take Route 80 to either of these exits and proceed on Route 46, continuing in the same direction from which you came. Take Boulevard North for approximately two miles. At the first fork bear left onto Elcock Ave. towards Powerville, for about two blocks. The entrance is on the left. Proceed to the second parking lot. Paul Meyer will lead the 10 a.m. foray.

At the center of town veer left onto South Maple Ave. Take South Maple (passing Lord Stirling Riding Stables on the left) to Lord Stirling Road (airport on the right after you turn) and follow about a mile to the Environmental Center on the left.
